

Reporting guidance for issues that may be experienced by the communities of Epping Forest

Report to Essex Police

Always dial **999** when: a serious crime is believed in progress or has recently occurred; someone is in immediate danger or harm; property is in danger of being damaged or a serious disruption to the public is likely. There are many ways to report a variety of non-urgent matters online at **www.essex.police.uk**, as an alternative to calling **101**. This includes a Live Chat service operated daily between 7am-11pm, with reports dealt with in the same way as when calling 101.

Report to CrimeStoppers/Fearless

CrimeStoppers is a charity independent of the police, who will take information from members of the public ensuring 100% anonymity, passing this to the police to act upon. CrimeStoppers can receive information via their website or by phone on **0800 555 111**. There is some information CrimeStoppers cannot process, such as if the informant is reporting an emergency or is a victim of crime. Fearless is the youth branch of CrimeStoppers and works in the same way for young people, with online reporting.
