

Public notice

The Essex County Council (Footpath 62, and Footpath 65, Nazeing) (Temporary Prohibition of Use) Order 2024

Notice is hereby given that further to a Notice on the 03 October 2024 the Essex County Council has made the above Order under section S14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended).

Effect of the order: Further to a Notice on the 03 October 2024 Essex County Council has temporarily closed Footpath 62, Nazeing from its junction with Middle Street to its junction with Footpath 56, Nazeing, and Footpath 65, Nazeing from its junction with Footpath 62 to its junction with Footpath 66, Nazeing.

The closure comes into effect on the 24 October 2024 and is required for the safety of the public and workforce while works on the replacement of a 3.5 metre pedestrian bridge take place.

The alternative route is via Footpaths 56, 57, and 66, Nazeing, and vice versa.

The Order will come into effect on 24 October 2024 and may continue in force for six months, or until the works have been completed, whichever is the earlier. This Order may be extended by the Secretary of State if an extension is required.
