ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTION 14(2)

Temporary Closure of Footpaths 62, and 65 Nazeing

Notice is hereby given that from the date specified below, the Essex County Council has temporarily closed to all pedestrians under section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended),

Footpath 62, Nazeing from its junction with Middle Street to its junction with Footpath 56, Nazeing.

Footpath 65, Nazeing from its junction with Footpath 62 to its junction with Footpath 66, Nazeing.

The closure comes into effect on the 03 October 2024 for 21 days and is required for the safety of the public and workforce due to an unsafe pedestrian bridge.



The alternative route is via Footpaths 56, 57, and 66, Nazeing, and vice versa.

Works to replace a pedestrian bridge are proposed, the closure will be continued in force by Order under Section 14(1) in due course.
